Yuma County is pleased to inform you of the satisfactory result of testing your product.

As you are aware, Yuma County Public Works applied your product at a rate of .25 gallon per square yard to stabilize the top 2 inches of a well graded ½ inch minus, ABC road base. The product worked exactly as described. Within 8 hours after application, the road surface was hard enough to leave rubber black marks as the result of hard braking or acceleration.

We believe your product to represent a good value and works excellent to stabilize a road base course in preparation for a chip seal rural road.
